

ORDINANCE NO 2025-01

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PARKING OF SEMITRAILER TRUCKS,  
BOATS, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, AND CERTAIN TRAILERS ON THE STREETS  
OF THE CITY OF ST GEORGE, KANSAS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. PARKING PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or cause to be parked any truck tractor, trailer, semitrailer, recreational vehicle, boat with trailer, camper, or other trailer of more than 6 feet in length, owned or under the physical control of such person, on any highway or street in the city, for a period of time longer than Forty-Eight (48) hours at any time; provided, that this section shall not apply to vehicles owned by the United States of America, the state and the city or if otherwise allowed by city code.


As used herein, the term “park” or “cause to be parked” means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers or while engaged in residential or commercial construction or repair work.

Movement of the vehicle from one location to another on any city street or highway shall not be deemed to start a new Forty-Eight (48) hour period.


SECTION 2. REPEAL. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
